WHISTLE BLOWING POLICY

Employees may, in properly carrying out their duties, have access to, or come into contact with information of a confidential nature. The terms and conditions provide that except in the proper performance of your duties, employees are forbidden from disclosing or making use of in any form whatsoever such confidential information. However, the law allows employees to make a 'protected disclosure' of certain information. In order to be 'protected', a disclosure must relate to a specific subject matter (listed below) and the disclosure must also be made in an appropriate way.

If in the course of employment an employee becomes aware of information which they reasonably believe tends to show one or more of the following, they must use the Organisation's disclosure procedure set out below:

- That a criminal offence has been committed, is being committed or is likely to be committed;
- That a person has failed, is failing or is likely to fail to comply with any legal obligation to which he is subject;
- That a miscarriage of justice that has occurred, is occurring, or is likely to occur;
- That the health and safety of any individual has been, is being, or is likely to be, endangered;
- That the environment, has been, is being, or is likely to be, damaged;
- That information tending to show any of the above is being or is likely to be deliberately concealed.

Disclosure Procedure

Information which an employee reasonably believes tends to show one or more of the above should promptly be disclosed to their manager so that any appropriate action can be

taken. If it is inappropriate to make such a disclosure to the manager, the employee should speak to:
